Race Fact Sheet

- What:** ING Georgia Marathon & Half Marathon
- Where:** Atlanta, Georgia. The start and finish line will be at Centennial Olympic Park.
- When:** Sunday, March 30, 2008
- Who:** 15,000 runners and wheelers, amateurs and professionals
- Web site:** www.inggeorgiamarathon.com
- Start Time:** 6:55 am Wheelchair start; 7:00 am Runners start will be staggered by expected finish times
- Registration:** The event is expected to sell out again in 2008 with 15,000 participants. Through Dec. 31, 2007, registration for the half marathon (runners and wheelers) will be \$60 and registration for the marathon is \$80. Registration prices will increase on January 1, 2008 to \$75/\$95.
- Distance:** Marathon- 26.2 miles and Half Marathon- 13.1 miles (wheelchair race is half marathon distance). There is a 7 hour time limit.
- Official Course:** The start line will be positioned outside Centennial Olympic Park on Marietta Street in downtown Atlanta. Runners and wheelers will proceed east along Marietta as they follow the official route marked in orange. All participants will end the race on the north side of the park, along Baker Street adjacent to Centennial Olympic Park. The park will host activities for spectators and runners all day.
- Expo:** Health & Fitness Expo is free and will be located at the Georgia World Congress Center on Friday March 28 (9 a.m. to 8 p.m.) and Saturday March 29 (9 a.m. to 6 p.m.). The Expo is where event participants pick up race packets, and all exhibits are open to the public. Special guest speakers will include Dick Beardsley, Scott Rigsby and Nancy Clark. More details are listed at the official Web site.
